ESDF “Golden Ticket” Scholarship Raffle Rules

- Scholarship Award will be deposited directly into a COUNTRY Trust Bank/Bright Direction 529 educational plan. No other disbursement options will be permitted. All initial sales fees will be waived by COUNTRY
- Cost of each raffle ticket is \$100
- Acceptable and non-acceptable forms of payment
- No credit card or cash payments
- Checks from individuals and businesses are acceptable, but a \$50.00 service fee will be charged on all returned checks.
- No third party checks
- No extensions of credit of any type
- People under the age of 18 years are allowed to sell tickets but cannot buy the tickets, nor are they allowed to win. The winner of a “Golden Ticket” may award scholarship to anyone, regardless of age or place of residence
- No other gambling is permitted with or in addition to this raffle
- No gifts, credit or loans can be given to entice purchase of raffle ticket except for the raffle prize
- All ticket owners must have the chance to win
- Transactions must be complete with transfer of the ticket - no payment, no ticket purchased
- Accurate monthly records must account for:
 - The purchaser’s name and the ticket number purchased, along with the recipient listed on the ticket (if not the same). A listed recipient of the prize is not required on the ticket but is encouraged
 - Monetary amount of purchase
- 100% of gross ticket sales and receipts of records will be collected from all sources and deposited in separate account set up for the raffle at First Independent Bank
- Ticket payment checks must be deposited at any First Independent Bank. The purchase record form, including the ticket number, must be completed and turned into the Bank and forwarded to Katie Kalua at 16821 SE McGillivray Blvd #213 Vancouver, WA 98683 with in a timely manner of the ticket sale, preferably weekly
- Board members and Board executive committee members shall be permitted to purchase raffle tickets

- Raffle drawing will be held on the evening of May 22, 2010 at the Vancouver Hilton or other location designated by ESDF Raffle Committee. The City of Vancouver Police Chief or other official designated by the ESDF Raffle Committee will conduct the raffle drawing. Winners need not be present to win; all winners will be notified within 2 business days of verification of winning ticket
- Taxes are the sole responsibility of ticket owner, please check with your tax advisor
- If a winning ticket is left unclaimed, a certified letter will be sent to the address on the winning ticket, specifying the response time period. If not claimed within the stated time period, the prize will be forfeited back to Evergreen School District Foundation.
